

at the expense of the owner, in the manner prescribed in Article 6 (1) of Order (No. 4).

(2.) A copy of a Licence which authorizes movement to premises in a District other than the District for which the person granting the Licence acts as Inspector shall forthwith be sent by the Inspector to the Local Authority of the District in which the place of destination is situate.

Holding of Markets and Sales in Zone II.

5.—(1.) A market or sale of animals may be held on any premises in Zone II. if the Local Authority are satisfied that the market or sale will be restricted to animals intended for immediate slaughter and the market or sale is authorised by the Local Authority under this Article.

(2.) The Local Authority shall cause a Veterinary Inspector to attend at every market or sale authorised under this Article and examine the animals exposed thereat.

(3.) An animal exposed at a market or sale authorised under this Article shall not be moved therefrom except to a slaughterhouse or bacon factory, and unless it is accompanied by a licence authorising such movement granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the district in which the market or sale is situate. The animal shall, before such movement, be marked, by and at the expense of the owner, in the manner described in Article 6 of Order No. 4.

Movement of Animals through Zones or Prohibited Areas by Railway.

6. For the purposes of this Order, an animal shall not be deemed to be moved into or out of a Zone or Prohibited Area where it is moved through such Zone or Area by railway from a place outside such Zone or Area to another place outside such Zone or Area, without unnecessary delay and without the animal being untrucked within such Zone or Area except for the purposes of feeding or watering the animals within the railway station premises where such untrucking takes place.

Provision as to Farms on borders of Zones or Prohibited Areas.

7. If any farm (*except any detached part*) is partly within and partly outside a Prohibited Area, the whole shall be deemed to be within the Area. Subject to this provision, if any farm (*except any detached part*) is partly within and partly outside a Zone, the whole shall be deemed to be within the Zone, and where the farm extends to two Zones the whole shall be deemed to be in the inner Zone.

Commencement.

8. This Order shall come into operation on the seventeenth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifteen.

Short Title, &c.

9. This Order may be cited as the SOMERSET AND DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1915 (No. 5), and shall be read with the Orders referred to in Article 1.

SCHEDULE.

Prohibited Area No. 1.

An Area comprising:—

The city and county borough of Bath;

The parishes of Monkton Combe, Claverton, Bathford, Bathampton, Batheaston, St. Catherine, Swainswick, Woolley, Charlcombe, Langridge, Weston, English Combe, Combe Hay, South Stoke, Freshford, Hinton Charterhouse, Farleigh Hungerford, Tellisford, and Norton St. Philip; and such portion of the parish of Wellow as lies to the north and east of the road leading from Faulkland (*via Hassage Hill, Wellow and Bath Hill*) to Combe Hay (*but excluding such road*), in the administrative county of Somerset; and

The parishes of Winkfield, Bradford Without, Westwood, Limpley Stoke, Winsley, Bradford on Avon, Monkton Farleigh, and Scuth Wraxall, and such portion of the parish of Box as lies to the south and west of the road leading from Bradford on Avon (*via Hatt House, Box, Ditteridge, and The Rocks*) to Marshfield (*but excluding such road*), in the administrative county of Wilts.

Prohibited Area No. 2.

An Area, in the administrative county of Somerset, comprising the parishes of Brislington, Whitechurch, Norton Malreward, Queen Charlton, Keynsham, Burnett, Compton Dando, and Publow; and

Such portion of the parish of Stanton Drew as lies to the north and east of the road leading from Chelwood (*via Stanton Wick Farm, Bromley Farm and Stanton Drew*) to Norton Malreward (*but excluding such road*).

Zone I.

A Zone comprising:—

In the Administrative County of Gloucester.

The parishes of Mangotsfield, Kingswood, Siston, Oldland, Hanham Abbots, Bitton, and Cold Ashton, and such portion of the parish of Marshfield as lies to the south of the road leading from Cold Ashton via Marshfield and Star House to North Wraxall.

In the Administrative County of Wilts.

The petty sessional division of Trowbridge;
The petty sessional division of Bradford, excluding such portion thereof as is comprised in Prohibited Area No. 1;

The parishes of Heywood and West Ashton;

Such portions of the parishes of Steeple Ashton, Great Hinton, Semington, and Melksham Without as lie to the west of a boundary line following the main road from Westbury via Bratton, Steeple Ashton, Ashton Common, and Semington, to the boundary of the parish of Melksham Within, and thence following the boundary of that parish in a westerly direction
