PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 59th year of His late Majesty King George the Third, Chapter 134, of the Act of the 2nd and 3rd years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 49, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Representation, bearing date the 18th day of November, in the year 1915, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 59th year of His late Majesty King George the Third, Chapter 134, of the Act of the 2nd and 3rd years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 49, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Representation as to the assignment of a District

Chapelry to the Consecrated Church of Saint Nicholas, Kingston-upon-Hull, situate in the Parish of Hessle, in the County of York, and in the Diocese of York:

“ Whereas it appears to us to be expedient that a District Chapelry should be assigned to the said Church of Saint Nicholas, Kingston-upon-Hull, situate as aforesaid:

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Honourable and Most Reverend Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York, (testified by his having signed and sealed this Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent that it would, in our opinion, be expedient that all that part of the said Parish of Hessle which is described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which part, together with the boundaries thereof, is delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, should be assigned as a District Chapelry to the said Church of Saint Nicholas, Kingston-upon-Hull, situate as aforesaid, and that the same should be named ‘The District Chapelry of Saint Nicholas, Kingston-upon-Hull’:
