

The Benefice of Barnwood is in the Patronage of the Dean and Chapter of Gloucester.

The Benefice of St. Mary de Lode is in the same Patronage.

The Benefice of Hempsted is in the Patronage of Mrs. Julia Charlotte Higford.

The Benefice of Quedgeley is in the Patronage of Colonel John Frederick Curtis Hayward.

The Benefice of Brookthorpe-with-Whaddon is in the Patronage of the Dean and Chapter of Gloucester and Sir Audley Dallas Neeld, Baronet, alternately (the said Sir Audley Dallas Neeld having the next turn).

"15. The Reverend Frederick Billett is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Saint James.

The Reverend William Christian Macklin is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Saint Mary de Lode.

The Reverend Aubrey Chastel de Boinville is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of All Saints.

The Reverend Francis Harvie Fowler is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Barnwood.

The Honourable and Reverend Charles Augustus Sinclair is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Hempsted.

The Reverend Frederick Ralph Grenside is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Quedgeley.

The Reverend Edmund Henry Blake is the present Incumbent of the Benefice of Brookthorpe-with-Whaddon.

"16. Pursuant to the directions contained in the 26th Section of the said Pluralities Act, I, the said Bishop, have drawn up a Scheme in writing, annexed to this Representation, describing the several Districts so as aforesaid proposed to be annexed to the said Parishes of Saint James, All Saints, Quedgeley, Hempsted, and Brookthorpe-with-Whaddon, and the mode in which it appears to me the alterations may best be effected, and how the changes consequent thereon in respect of Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction, Glebe Lands, Tithe Rent-Charges, and other Ecclesiastical Dues and Payments, and in respect to Patronage and Rights to Pews, may be made with justice to all parties interested. And I do hereby submit the same to your Grace, together with the Consents in writing of the said Patrons and Incumbents, to the intent that if your Grace shall on full consideration and inquiry be satisfied with such Scheme you may certify the same, and such Consents, by your Report to His Majesty in Council."

And whereas the said Scheme drawn up by the said Bishop and the Consents referred to in the said Representation are as follows:—

"SCHEME.

"That certain portions shall be separated from the said Parish of Barnwood and annexed for ecclesiastical purposes to the contiguous Parish of Saint James. The said portions (three in number) are delineated and described in Plan 'A' hereunto annexed and therein coloured *red* and lettered 'A,' and consist of the District known as the Coney Hill District.

"That a District shall be separated from the said Parish of Saint Mary de Lode and annexed for ecclesiastical purposes to the contiguous Parish of All Saints. The said District is delineated and described in Plan

'A' hereunto annexed and therein coloured *blue* and lettered 'B,' and is part of the District known as the Old T-Station District.

"That certain portions shall be separated from the said Parish of Hempsted and annexed for ecclesiastical purposes to the contiguous Parish of Quedgeley. The said portions (three in number) are delineated and described in Plan 'B' hereunto annexed and therein coloured *green* and lettered 'C,' and consist of the District known as the Canal District.

"That certain portions shall be separated from the said Parish of Quedgeley and annexed for ecclesiastical purposes to the contiguous Parish of Hempsted. The said portions (two in number) are delineated and described in Plan 'B' hereunto annexed and therein coloured *yellow* and lettered 'D,' and consist of the District known as the Bristol Road District.

"That a District shall be separated from the said Parish of Quedgeley and annexed for ecclesiastical purposes to the contiguous Parish of Brookthorpe-with-Whaddon. The said District is delineated and described in Plan 'C' hereunto annexed and therein coloured *red* and lettered 'E,' and consists of the District known as the Toots Farm District.

"That the respective Incumbents of the Parishes to which such several Districts shall be annexed shall have the sole and exclusive Cure of Souls within the said Districts.

"That the Parishioners of such several Districts shall be entitled to accommodation in the respective Churches of the Parishes to which the said Districts shall be annexed, and shall cease to be entitled to accommodation in the respective Churches of the Parishes from which the said Districts shall be separated, excepting, nevertheless, any person or persons possessing a legal right by faculty or otherwise to any Pew or Sitting in either of the said Parish Churches, and who may not be willing to relinquish and give up the same.

"That Marriages, Baptisms, Churchings, and Burials shall be solemnized and performed as follows:—

(a) For the Inhabitants of the Coney Hill District in the said Parish of Saint James.

(b) For the Inhabitants of the part of Old T-Station District in the said Parish Church of All Saints.

(c) For the Inhabitants of the Canal District in the said Parish Church of Quedgeley.

(d) For the Inhabitants of the Bristol Road District in the said Parish Church of Hempsted.

(e) For the Inhabitants of the Toots Farm District in the said Parish Church of Brookthorpe-with-Whaddon.

"That all Fees, Dues, Ecclesiastical Offerings, and Emoluments (excepting Tithe-Rent-Charge) arising from each of the Districts shall henceforth belong to the Incumbent of the Parish to which such District shall be annexed.

"That no alteration shall be made in the Patronage of the said Benefices or either of them."
