Rule 4.

The Great Seal and Wafer Seal in the Schedule hereto mean the Great Seal and the Wafer Great Seal within the meaning of the Crown Office Act, 1877.

Rule 5.

If in any particular case or cases it shall be found more convenient to pass any such documents under the Great Seal in the manner hitherto accustomed, or to use the material hitherto employed, the Lord Chancellor may direct the same to be done accordingly.
