sideration the said Petition, and is minded to make such alteration as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased to order, direct, and declare, as it is hereby ordered, directed, and declared:—

- 1. From and after the date hereof, alteration shall be made of the division heretofore made of the County Palatine of Lancaster for Coroners' purposes, and for the purposes of the Coroners Act, 1844, as follows, that is to say, the Salford Hundred portion of the Borough of Bacup (formerly part of the late Township of Spotland) shall be transferred from the Rochdale Coroner's District of the said County to the Blackburn Hundred Coroner's District of the said County.
- 2. The said Districts shall respectively comprise the several Parishes and Places in that behalf prescribed and mentioned in the Schedule hereto.
- 3. This Order shall be published in the London Gazette.
