ARMY COUNCIL ORDER.
COLONIAL WOOL.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, the Army Council do hereby order that all persons engaged in the purchase or sale of Colonial Wool shall comply with the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. No wool of the 1916-17 clip consigned to the United Kingdom from Australia or New Zealand on growers' account shall be sold or offered for sale otherwise than to the Director of Army Contracts or to persons authorised in his behalf.

2. All persons who have or may have in their custody or control any stocks of wool of the description aforesaid are hereby required to forward to the Director of Army Contracts, Raw Material Section, Imperial House, Tothill Street, Westminster, S.W., particulars of all such consignments immediately upon their arrival in the United Kingdom, and all such further particulars as may be required on his behalf, and to sell such wool as may be required by or on behalf of the Director of Army Contracts, on the terms and subject to

the conditions on and subject to which the sale thereof is authorised by this Order.
