Satisfactory proof of the identity of the applicant (whether the application is made personally or by proxy) must in all cases be produced at the time of application.

Medals awarded to *Warrant Officers, Non-commissioned Officers and men* will be sent for disposal to the Record Offices of the unit to which such *Warrant Officers, Non-commissioned Officers and men* belong.

B.—British Officers of the Indian Army and all other Indian ranks of the Indian Army.

All Decorations will be sent to the India Office for disposal.

British Officers of the Indian Army who are in the United Kingdom, or their duly accredited representatives, should apply to the Military Secretary, India Office.

C.—Dominion Forces and Colonial Contingents, inclusive of South African Brigade, in France, but exclusive of South African units serving in East Africa.
