The Insignia and Medals of the above Decorations have been entrusted to the Army Council, and will be distributed to the Officers, Non-commissioned Officers and men to whom they have been awarded, as under :-

A.—Regular Army, Territorial Force and Special Reserve.

Officers desirous of obtaining their Decorations should apply for them in person or through a duly accredited representative to Military Secretary, War Office (Foreign De-corations Section), 14, Albemarle Street, W.

Medals awarded to Warrant Officers, Noncommissioned Officers and men will be sent for disposal to the Record Offices of the unit to which such Warrant Officers, Non-commissioned Officers and men belong.

B.—British Officers of the Indian Army and all other Indian ranks of the Indian Army.

All Decorations will be sent to the India Office for disposal.

British Officers of the Indian Army who are in the United Kingdom, or their duly accre-dited representatives, should apply to the Military Secretary, India Office.

C.—Dominion Forces and Colonial Contingents.

Decorations awarded to all ranks will be sent. to the Administrative Headquarters concerned in London for disposal.
