ARMY COUNCIL ORDER.

CERTAIN CLASSES OF CART-HORSE COLLARS AND HAMES.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, the Army Council hereby give notice that it is their intention to take possession of all cart-horse collars and hames specified in Schedule A annexed to this Order that are in the hands of makers, merchants, or other persons in the areas indicated in Schedule B annexed to this Order, and not in regular use at the date hereof.

If after this notice any person having in his custody or control any such cart-horse collars and hames sells, removes or secretes the same or deals with them in any way contrary to any permit that may have been granted in respect thereof, he will be guilty of an offence against the said Regulations.

All persons having in their custody or control any such cart-horse collars or hames as defined in Schedule A hereof are hereby required to furnish to the Director of Raw Materials, Imperial House, Tothill Street, Westminster, S.W. 1, all such particulars as are specified in Schedule C hereto annexed and such further and other particulars as may be required by or on behalf of the Director of Raw Materials and verified as he may direct.
