ARMY COUNCIL ORDER.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, the Army Council hereby order as follows:—

All persons who have or may have in their custody, control, or possession any stocks of merino tops and all persons engaged in the production, manufacture, purchase or sale of merino tops are hereby required to furnish in writing to the Secretary of the District Priority Committee for the area in which they carry on business, particulars of all deliveries of merino tops which have been or may be made by them to spinners since the 30th day of June, 1917, whether in pursuance of con-

tracts entered into prior to the 30th day of June, 1917, or otherwise, and all such further particulars as may be required by or on behalf of the Secretary of such District Priority Committee.
