His Majesty The KING has been graciously pleased to approve of the award of the Military Cross to Lieutenant William Wallace Cook, N.Z. Forces and R.F.C.

For conspicuous gallantry and skill in an attack on a Zeppelin. He ascended from his station during strong wind, thick mist and low clouds and showed great determination, eventually giving up the attack when sixty miles out to sea.

His return journey was hazardous, but with great skill he eventually effected a landing in a field within a quarter of a mile of the coast, having been in the air for  $5\frac{1}{2}$  hours.
