

(d) in any other University in the United Kingdom, or any College, Public Hall or Public Hostel within such University; or

(e) in any University College in the United Kingdom" shall be substituted for the words

"any income not derived from an academic office in the University, or in any College, University, or University College in the United Kingdom."

Now, we, the said Warden and College, in pursuance of the provisions of the said Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, do hereby submit the aforesaid alteration made by us in the Statutes governing our said College to the King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council, and humbly pray that the same may be approved and confirmed.
