CARGOES EX GERMAN VESSELS IN BRAZILIAN PORTS.

With reference to the notification which was published in the London Gazette of June 26th last, His Majesty's Minister at Rio de Janeiro now reports by telegraph that cargo discharged from some of these vessels has been already over six months in warehouse, and that the legal rate of charges payable on such cargo is therefore in general 21 per cent., and on certain classes of cargo 42 per cent.
