PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, Chapter 77, of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, and of the Act of the 37th and 38th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 63, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme, bearing date the 13th day of December, in the year 1917, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, Chapter 77, of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, and of the Act of the 37th and 38th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 63, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme with respect to the Archdeaconries and Rural Deaneries in the Diocese of Norwich:

"Whereas the Archdeaconries and Rural Deaneries in the said Diocese of Norwich were set forth in the Statutory Schedule of Rural Deaneries prepared under the provisions of the hereinbefore thirdly-mentioned Act, and deposited in the Registry of the Diocese of Norwich at Norwich in the year 1875:

"And whereas there are within the said Diocese of Norwich 3 Archdeaconries, to wit the Archdeaconry of Lynn, the Archdeaconry of Norfolk, and the Archdeaconry of Norwich:

"And whereas it has been represented to us by the Right Reverend Partram, Bishop of the said Diocese of Norwich, that the arrangements
