

altered by the Swindon Order, 1902, which was confirmed by the Local Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 11) Act, 1902, the Swindon Corporation Act, 1904, and the Swindon Corporation (Wilts and Berks Canal Abandonment) Act, 1914, so as—

(1) To authorise the Corporation

(a) To purchase by agreement lands situate at Upper Poughcombe, in the parish of Ogbourne St. Andrew, belonging to the Provost and Scholars of the King's College, Cambridge, and now in the occupation of Mr. W. G. Wadman, and containing an area of 450 acres or thereabouts, and to construct thereon such wells and other works for the purposes of their water undertaking as may be approved by the Local Government Board;

(b) In connection with the said works to acquire by agreement the right to drive adits under and to sink shafts on and in a piece of land adjoining and lying to the north of the aforesaid lands and containing an area of 100 acres or thereabouts, and to carry out such works under, on and in the said piece of land;

(2) To make applicable to the water undertaking the provisions of section 54 of the Public Health Act, 1875 (which relate to the carrying of water mains by a local authority within or without their district) and any provisions of that Act incidental thereto, and to provide that for the purposes of those provisions as made applicable to the water undertaking the limits of the Corporation for the supply of water shall be deemed to be the district of the local authority;

(3) To partially repeal or amend section 14 of the said Act of 1914, so as to empower

the Corporation, subject to the provisions of the Act, to sell, for purposes other than domestic supply, water impounded by the Coate Reservoir;

(4) To empower the Corporation to borrow moneys for the purposes of the proposed Order; and

(5) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable;

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application:
