**MESOPOTAMIA DESPATCHES.**

In the Despatch from General Sir John Nixon, K.C.B., dated 17th January, 1916 (published in The London Gazette, No. 29576, dated 10th May, 1916), the following amendment is notified:—

Paragraph 18 (page 4659), lines 1 to 6 should be cancelled, and the following passage substituted:—

“The ships reached Umm Al Tubal in the afternoon of 30th November and remained in company with the troops for the night. General Townshend issued orders for a resumption of the withdrawal in the morning; but during the night the enemy came up and attacked in great strength at daylight on 1st December.”
