## ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 29TH APRIL 1918.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

### *Application of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1914.*

1.—(1) The provisions of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") are hereby applied to each of the Areas described in the Schedule hereto.

(2) While this Order remains in operation sheep in the Areas described in the Schedule hereto shall be exempt from the provisions of Article 3 of the Sheep Dipping (Scotland and North of England) Order of 1915 so far as they relate to dipping within the first prescribed dipping period.

### *Modification of Part I of the Principal Order.*

2. Part I of the Principal Order shall, in its application to the Areas described in the Schedule hereto, be read and have effect as if paragraph (3) of Article 2 of that Order were omitted.

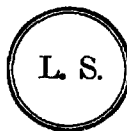
### *Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.*

3. The dates between which all sheep in the Areas described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Areas by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part II of the principal Order, are hereby fixed to be the fifteenth day of July and the thirty-first day of August.

### *Commencement.*

4. This Order shall come into operation on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and eighteen.

## SCHEDULE.

### *Areas referred to in this Order.*

The following Areas in the county of Sutherland, namely:—

1. An Area comprising such part of the parish of Tongue as lies within the following boundary (*but excluding any part of Mr. J. D. Cameron's farm falling within such Area*):—

Commencing at the mouth of the river Borgie, and proceeding in a southerly direction along the west bank of that river, Loch Slain, Loch Craggie, and the western and southern banks of Loch Loyal to the eastern boundary of the parish; thence in south-easterly and south-westerly directions along the parish boundary to the eastern bank of Loch Meadie; thence in a northerly
