

THE ADMIRALTY (CITATION AND PRINTING OF WAR MATERIAL SUPPLIES ORDERS) ORDER, 1918.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Admiralty by the Defence of the Realm Regulations and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, it is hereby ordered as follows:—

2. This Order may be cited as "The Admiralty (Citation of War Material Supplies Orders) Order, 1918.
