Supper.—Five ounces of bread, one pint of tea with milk and sugar, two ounces of cheese	4d.
Class II. Airmen only.	
Lodging (with bed and attendance) for each airman, per night, when no meals are furnished and no cooking facilities are required	6d.
Class III. Officers and Airmen.	
(a) Unfurnished accommodation in occupied premises, for each officer or airman	2d.

HORSES. Class I. (i.e., Stabling and Forage).	
Stable room and 10 lbs. of oats, 12 lbs. of hay, and 8 lbs. of straw per day for each horse	3s. for the first 14 days; 2s. 4d. after 14 consecutive days.

Proper stabling, but without forage	6d.
Class III.	
Accommodation in buildings where proper stabling is not provided per night	3d.
