SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)  
ACT, 1915.

Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915:  
Further extension of time limited by Section 45 of the Fylde Water Board Act, 1912.

FYLDE WATER BOARD.

To the Fylde Water Board;—  
And to all others whom it may concern.

**W**HEREAS by virtue of the provisions of Section 45 of the Fylde Water Board Act, 1912 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1912"), and of an Order dated the 4th day of August, 1917, issued by Us, the Local Government Board, under Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1915"), the time limited for the exercise of the powers of the Fylde Water Board for the compulsory purchase under the Act of 1912 of the lands necessary for Works Nos. 1, 3, 5, and 7, authorised by the Act of 1912, will expire on the 7th day of August, 1918:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 1 of the Act of 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, We, by this Our Order, extend until the 7th day of August, 1919, the time limited as aforesaid for the exercise of the powers of the Fylde Water Board for the compulsory purchase of the lands aforesaid.

EDENBRIDGE AND DISTRICT GAS ACT,  
1914.

SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT,  
1915.

**B**Y virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915, the Board of Trade hereby extend for one year, from the 7th August, 1918, the time limited by Sections 22 and 54 respectively of the Edenbridge and District Gas Act, 1914, for the laying down of the mains referred to in those sections and for the furnishing by the Company of a supply of gas in the parishes of Chiddingstone, Cowden, and Hever, and in part of the parish of Penshurst.
