ADMIRALTY NOTICE TO MARINERS.

Notice is hereby given that, under the
Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regula-
tions, 1914, the following Regulations have
been made by the Lords Commissioners of the
Admiralty and are now in force:—

(1) *Beachy Head to St. Albans Head—Traffic
Regulations.*

I. REGULATIONS REGARDING TRAD- ING, FISHING AND PLEASURE CRAFT.

1. The areas on the South Coast of England
to which the following orders apply are:—

Area A.—Enclosed by a line from Beachy
head to Owers light-vessel to Boulder bank
buoy, thence in a 315° (N. 30° W. Mag.)
direction to the Portsmouth Defence area.

Area B.—Enclosed by a line from Culver
cliff to a point 3 miles, 90° (S. 75° E. Mag.),
from Culver cliff, thence within the 3-mile
limit to a point 3 miles, 180° (S. 15° W.
