

(3) The extension of the Company's supply mains in the parishes of Tonbridge, Hildenborough, Leigh and Shipbourne, all in the said county of Kent.

(4) The extension of the existing filtration plant on the lands hereinbefore described or some of them.

(5) The sinking of bore holes or wells into the lower strata on the said lands or some of them.

(6) The installation of new pumping machinery on the lands hereinbefore described or some of them.

(7) The erection of new buildings for the purposes of the Company's undertaking on the said lands or some of them.

And all needful works connected therewith.

3. To authorize the Company

(a) To execute and do on any lands for the time being held by them all or some of the works, matters and things mentioned or referred to in section 12 of the Waterworks Clauses Act, 1847.

(b) To acquire by agreement the land thirdly hereinbefore described and also from time to time any other lands and property within the aforesaid parishes and elsewhere, and to hold such acquired lands for the purposes of the water undertaking, and to purchase, lease, erect, fit up and maintain houses, offices and other buildings, and from time to time to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of lands held by the Company or any part thereof.

(c) To collect, divert, take, impound, convey, use and appropriate all springs and waters found in, upon or under any land acquired or held by the Company.

4. To increase the capital and borrowing powers of the Company for the purposes of their undertaking, to define and regulate the dividends payable on any class or classes of share or loan capital of the Company, to continue and maintain or alter the respective rights of the holders of any such class or classes of capital in the profits of the Company or otherwise and to empower the Company to apply all or any of their capital funds and revenues to all or any of the purposes of the intended Order.

5. To define the expression "domestic purposes" and to limit the user of water supplied at the rates for domestic purposes specified in the Order of 1886 or which may be specified in the intended Order; to empower the Company to require that water supplied for farming purposes and to buildings partly used for trade or manufacturing purposes shall be taken by meter and to prescribe the charges leviable by the Company for water supplied by measure or for building purposes.

6. To make special provision with respect to the following matters:—The prevention of waste and contamination of the Company's water; the recovery of rates in respect of houses let on short tenancies and houses supplied by a common pipe; the provision of separate pipes for each house supplied; the alteration, repairing, connecting and disconnecting of meters; the repairing and maintenance of communication pipes and the conferring of special powers on the Company and on consumers with reference thereto; the discharge of water temporarily from any of the Company's works into any available stream or watercourse; the exemp-

tion of fittings from liability to distress or to be taken in execution; the power to remove water meters and fittings; the recovery of demands and penalties; the notices to be given by consumers in certain cases.

7. To authorize the Company to make bye-laws and regulations in connection with any of the provisions of the intended Order and to provide for the enforcement of such bye-laws and regulations by means of penalties and otherwise.

8. To empower the Company for the purpose of preventing or detecting waste to lay down, affix and maintain meters, stopcocks, covers and other apparatus in, under or on any mains or pipes of the Company, or their consumers, or any streets, roads or other places.

9. To extend to streets and roads not dedicated to public use all or any of the provisions and to authorize the Company to exercise in regard to such streets and roads all or any of the powers of the Water Works Clauses Acts relating to public streets and roads.

10. To amend section 23 of the Order of 1886 and to alter or extend the powers of the Company with regard to the supply of water in bulk or otherwise within and beyond their limits of supply.

11. To authorize the Company to enter into and carry into effect contracts and agreements with the owners, lessees and occupiers of any lands or property which will be affected by any of the works to be authorized by the intended Order, or with the authorities for any roads so affected, or any other authorities, bodies or persons with reference to the execution of such works, and the abstraction of water thereby, the exercise of any of the powers of the intended Order, and the supply of water along the route, or in the neighbourhood of such works, and if thought fit to sanction, confirm and give effect to any such contracts or agreements which may have been, or may hereafter be, entered into by the Company.

12. To incorporate with the Order so far as applicable and except so far as is varied thereby all or some of the provisions of the Water Works Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1863, and the Lands Clauses Acts, and to alter, extend or repeal the provisions of the Orders of 1886 and 1900 with reference to all or any of the matters aforesaid and in other respects, and to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges inconsistent with or which would interfere with the purposes of the Order, and to confer other rights and privileges.

13. And generally to confer upon the Company all such powers, rights and privileges as are usually conferred upon Water Companies, or which may be necessary or expedient for carrying into execution any of the objects of the intended Order.

Notice is hereby further given, that on or before the 30th day of November, 1918, plans and sections of the proposed new works, together with a copy of this Notice as published in the London Gazette, will be deposited at the Office of the Board of Trade, Whitehall, London; and also for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Kent, at his office at Maidstone.
