

Kidmore End, the boundaries of which are more particularly described in the hereinafter mentioned Scheme of the said Lord Bishop of Oxford, appended hereto, may be advantageously separated from the said Parish of Kidmore End and annexed to the contiguous Parish of Rotherfield Peppard:

"That pursuant to the directions contained in the said Pluralities Act the said Lord Bishop has made up a Scheme in writing describing the mode in which it appears to him that the proposed alterations may best be effected, and how the changes consequent upon such alterations in respect of Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction, Glebe Lands, Tithes, Rent-Charges, and other Ecclesiastical Dues, Rates, and Payments, and in respect to Patronage and Rights to Pews, may be made with justice to all parties interested, which Scheme, together with the Consents in writing of the said Lord Bishop of Oxford, by virtue of his Bishopric, the Patron or person entitled to present to the said Benefice of Kidmore End (in case the same were now vacant) the Reverend Bertram Hugh Bird, the Incumbent of the same Benefice, the Principal, Fellows, and Scholars of Jesus College, in the City and University of Oxford, of Queen Elizabeth's Foundation, the Patrons or persons entitled to present to the Benefice of Rotherfield Peppard (in case the same were now vacant) and the Reverend Maurice Jones, D.D., the Incumbent of the same Benefice, have been transmitted to us for our consideration:

"The Representation and Scheme of the said Lord Bishop, and the Consents above referred to, are hereunto annexed:

"And we, the said Archbishop, being on full consideration and Inquiry satisfied with the said Scheme, do hereby, pursuant to the said Pluralities Act, certify the same, and such Consents as aforesaid, to Your Majesty in Council, to the intent that Your Majesty in Council may, in case Your Majesty in Council shall think fit so to do, make and issue an Order for carrying the said Scheme into effect.

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the said Scheme be carried into effect.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme, bearing date the 16th day of October, 1918, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd

and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Rectory) of Moreton-upon-Lugg, situate in the County of Hereford, and in the Diocese of Hereford, for a part or share of the Patronage of the Benefice of Felton (being a Rectory) with the Vicarage of Preston Wynne annexed, situate in the said County of Hereford, and in the said Diocese of Hereford:

"Whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Moreton-upon-Lugg is vested in the Bishop of Worcester for the time being:

"And whereas two one-third parts or shares of and in the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Felton with Preston Wynne, that is to say, the second and third turns of every set of three turns of presentation to the said Benefice, are vested in Harriett Abiah Hill, of Moreton Court, in the said County of Hereford, Widow:

"And whereas the Right Reverend Huyshe Wolcott, now Bishop of Worcester, and the said Harriett Abiah Hill, have respectively signified to us their desire that the Patronage of the said two Benefices of Moreton-upon-Lugg and Felton with Preston Wynne may be rearranged by way of exchange in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed:

"And whereas we have made due inquiry and calculation as to the circumstances and relative values of the said two Benefices, and of the Patronage thereof, respectively, and we do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council that the circumstances and present values of the said two Benefices are as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Huyshe Wolcott, Bishop of Worcester, acting as such Bishop (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme, and sealed the same with his Episcopal Seal) and with the consent of the said Harriett Abiah Hill (in testimony whereof she has signed and sealed this Scheme) We, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Moreton-upon-Lugg, and the Church thereof, shall be assigned and transferred from the said Huyshe Wolcott, Bishop of Worcester, and from his Successors in the said Bishopric, and shall become and be absolutely vested in, and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised by, the said Harriett Abiah Hill, her heirs and assigns for ever, and that in exchange for the same the said two one-third parts or shares of and in the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Felton with Preston Wynne, and the Church thereof, shall in like manner and upon and from the same date be assigned and transferred from the said Harriett Abiah Hill, and shall become and be absolutely vested in, and shall and may from time to time and at all times be exercised
