

Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, bearing date the 18th May, 1897, the Salary of the Head Master at the Royal Hospital School, Greenwich, was fixed at £300 a year, rising to £350 after a period of five years:

"And whereas by Your Majesty's Order in Council of the 16th November, 1916, the Salaries of the Masters and the Assistant Masters employed in the Royal Hospital School were fixed at the following rates, viz.:—

"Upper Nautical School.

Master. £180 to £215 (with residence) - - - - - } By £5 a year:
As may be requisite. Assistant Masters. £150 to £200 - - - - - }

"Nautical School.

Two Masters. £170 to £205 (with residences) - - - - - } By £5 a year:
As may be requisite. Assistant Masters. £90 to £180 - - - - - }

"And whereas we are of opinion that, under existing conditions, a revision of the scales of Salaries of the Teaching Staff is desirable:—

"We beg leave humbly to recommend that

Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the substitution, as from the 8th August, 1918, of the undermentioned scales of Salaries for those at present in force, viz.:—

'Head Master (with residence) - - - - - £330 to £480 by £15 a year.

"Upper Nautical School.

Master (with residence) - - - - - £250 to £350 by £10 a year.
As may be requisite. Assistant Masters - - - - - £160 to £300, by £10 a year to £220, then £240, then by £20 every 3 years.

"Nautical School.

Two Masters (with residences) - - - - - £240 to £340 by £10 a year.
As may be requisite. Assistant Masters - - - - - £100 to £280, by £10 a year to £220, then £240, then by £20 every 3 years."

His Majesty, having taken the said Memorial into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve of what is therein proposed.

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty are to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

WHEREAS His Majesty has been pleased, in exercise of the power in that behalf conferred on Him by Section one, sub-section one, of the Trading with the Enemy (Extension of Powers) Act, 1915, by divers Proclamations, and in particular by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of May, 1916, and amended on the 16th day of January, 1918, entitled "The Trading with the Enemy (Statutory List) Proclamation," to prohibit all persons or bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated, resident, carrying on business, or being in the United Kingdom from trading with any of the persons or bodies of persons mentioned in the List contained in the last-mentioned Proclamation, such List being therein referred to as the Statutory List:

And whereas by Section one, sub-section two, of the said Act, it is provided that any List of persons and bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated, with whom such trading is prohibited by a Proclamation under the said Act may be varied or added to by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of a Secretary of State:

And whereas the Statutory List contained in the last-mentioned Proclamation, has been varied and added to by subsequent Orders of Council:
