

them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Revocation.

1. The Yorkshire (West Riding) (Leeds District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1919 (No. 4) is hereby revoked.

Modification of Orders (Nos. 1-3).

2. The Yorkshire (West Riding) (Leeds District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1919, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order," the Yorkshire (West Riding) (Leeds District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Orders of 1919 (Nos. 2 and 3), hereinafter referred to as "Order (No. 2)" and "Order (No. 3)," respectively, are modified in manner hereinafter appearing.

Extension of Scheduled District.

3. The Scheduled District to which the above-mentioned Orders apply shall be extended to include the area described in the First Schedule hereto.

Prohibition of Movement in certain Prohibited Areas.

4. The prohibition of movement of animals contained in the principal Order shall apply without modification to the Areas described in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the Prohibited Areas).

Movement in to and within extended Scheduled District (except the Prohibited Areas).

Holding of Licensed Fat Stock Markets.

5. The provisions of Order No. 3 applicable to the Zones described in the First Schedule hereto shall apply to the Scheduled District as extended by this Order (except the Prohibited Areas).

Short Title, &c.

6. This Order may be cited as the YORKSHIRE (WEST RIDING) (LEEDS DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1919 (No. 5), and shall be read with the Orders referred to in Article 2.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Area added to the Scheduled District.

An Area comprising the parishes of Mytholmroyd, Somerby (including its detached part), Soyland, Rishworth, Scammonden, Slaithwaite, Marsden, Meltham, Uppertong, Netherthong, Austonley, Cartworth, Holme, Scholes, Wooldale, Fulstone, and Hepworth.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Prohibited Areas referred to in this Order.

1. An Area comprising the Borough of Pudsey, the Parish of Farsley and parts of the

Parishes of Horsforth and Calverley in the administrative County of the West Riding of Yorkshire and also such part of the City and County Borough of Leeds as lie within the following boundary:—

Commencing at Kirkstall Bridge near Kirkstall Midland Railway Station and proceeding in a north-westerly direction along the south side of the said railway to where it joins the Leeds and Liverpool Canal near Apperley Bridge Junction; thence in a south-westerly direction along the southern bank of the said canal to the eastern boundary of the City and County Borough of Bradford, near the Bradford Corporation Sewage Works; thence in southerly, westerly, easterly, south-westerly and easterly directions along the said County Borough boundary via Bill Wood, Moorside Farm, Junction Inn, Broad Lane Junction and Black Carr Wood to where it meets Union Bridge in Roker Lane; thence in south-easterly and north-easterly directions along Roker Lane and Tong Road to Butt Lane; thence in a northerly direction along Butt Lane and Henconner Lane to the junction of the latter with Green Hill Road, near Green Hill Farm; thence in easterly and northerly directions along Green Hill Road and Cockshott Lane to Amen Corner at Kirkstall; thence in a northerly direction along Wyther Lane to the point of commencement.

2. An area comprising:—

In the administrative county of the West Riding of Yorkshire:—

The Borough of Brighouse, and
The Parishes of Southowram, Greetland, Upper Greetland, Norland, Barkland, Elland, Fixby, Stainland with Old Lindley, Golcar, Linthwaite, and South Crosland.

And also comprising:—

The County Borough of Huddersfield.
