

And whereas it is expedient that certain Goatskin and Sheepskin Leather should be dealt in without restriction;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, the Army Council hereby give notice as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything in the Leather (Control) No. 5 Notice, 1917, dealings in Rough Tanned Goatskin Leather imported into the United Kingdom after the date hereof, and Tanned or Dressed Sheepskin Leather imported into the United Kingdom after the date hereof, are authorised and permitted without restriction.

2. This Order may be cited as the Imported Goatskin and Sheepskin Leather Permit, 1919.

THE IMPORTED LEATHER (BRITISH EMPIRE) PERMIT, 1919.

Whereas by the Leather (Control) No. 5 Notice, 1917, the Army Council regulated upon certain conditions dealings in certain Leather;

And whereas it is expedient that certain Leather should be dealt in without restrictions;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, the Army Council hereby give notice as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything in the Leather (Control) No. 5 Notice, 1917, dealings in all Leather imported into the United Kingdom after the date hereof and produced in any part of the British Empire are authorised and permitted without restriction.

2. This Order may be cited as the Imported Leather (British Empire) Permit, 1919.
