#### SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1915.

#### PEMBROKE GAS. [H.L.] (Additional Provision.)

(Acquisition of Lands for Manufacture of Gas and Residual Products.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the present Session by the Pembroke Docks and Town Gas Company Limited by petition for additional provision for leave to introduce into the Bill now pending in Parliament under the above name or title provisions and amendments to give effect to the following purposes (that is to say):—

To empower the Company proposed to be incorporated by the said Bill (hereinafter called "the Company") to purchase and take by compulsion or agreement a piece of land hereinafter described, or some part or parts thereof, or any rights or interests therein, and to extinguish all rights of way or other rights, if any, over the same (that is to say):—

A piece of land in the parish of Saint Mary, Pembroke, in the borough of Pembroke, containing 7 acres or thereabouts, bounded on the northern side by London-road on the southern side by land belonging or reputed to belong to the Great Western Railway Company, on the east by an imaginary line drawn parallel to and at a distance of forty-six yards westward of the west side of the road called Lanion-terrace, and on the western and north-western sides by lands belonging or reputed to belong to Sir Thomas Meyrick, Baronet, and to authorize the Company to construct, maintain, extend, improve, renew or discontinue upon the said piece of land hereinbefore described gasworks and works for the conversion, manufacture, utilization and distribution of materials used in and about or resulting from the manufacture of gas and residual and manufactured products, matters and things, and to manufacture gas, and to manufacture, convert, utilize, buy, sell and dispose of all other residual and manufactured products, matters and things.

And notice is hereby given, that a plan and duplicate thereof showing the lands to be taken or used compulsorily under the powers sought by the additional provision and a book of reference to such plan and a copy of this notice as published in the London Gazette will, on or before the 20th day of May instant, be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Pembroke, at his office at Haverfordwest, and on or before the same day a copy of the said plan, book of reference and Gazette notice will be deposited with the Town Clerk of the Borough of Pembroke, at his office at Pembroke.
