THE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL FOR THE URBAN DISTRICT OF ABERDARE, IN THE COUNTY OF GLAMORGAN.

WE, the Urban District Council for the Urban District of Aberdare, in the County of Glamorgan, hereby give notice, that we have made a certain bye-law with respect to the Tramways and Trackless Trolley Routes in the Urban District of Aberdare, which shall be read and construed with the bye-laws and regulations made by the Urban District Council of Aberdare, on the 28th day of July, 1913. A copy of the bye-law is deposited at our office at the Town Hall, High Street, Aberdare, and will be open during office hours thereat to the inspection of ratepayers of the district without fee or reward for the space of one calendar month from and after the 16th day of July, 1919, and that we, the said Local Authority as Promoters, shall at the expiration of such one calendar month apply to the Board of Trade (Railway Department) for confirmation of such bye-law.

THE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL OF ABERDARE.

Bye-laws and regulations made by the Urban District Council of Aberdare as the Promoters of the Tramways and Trackless Trolley Routes in the Urban District of Aberdare, under the Tramways Act, 1870, and the Aberdare Urban District Council Act, 1911.

1. Bye-law 11 made by the Urban District Council of Aberdare on the 28th day of July, 1913, is hereby rescinded.

2. Each passenger shall either on demand or before leaving the car, whichever shall first happen, pay to the conductor or other duly authorised officer of the Council the fare legally demandable for the journey.

3. These bye-laws and regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1919, and shall be read and construed with the bye-laws and regulations made by the Urban District Council of Aberdare on the 28th day of July, 1913.
