#### PRESENT.

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

W HEREAS by an Order in Council, dated the twenty-eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and fourteen, His Majesty was pleased to make regulations (called the "Defence of the Realm Regulations") under the Defence of the Realm Consolidation Act, 1914, for securing the public safety and the defence of the realm:

And whereas the said Act has been amended by the Defence of the Realm (Amendment) Act, 1915, the Defence of the Realm (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1915, and the Munitions of War Act, 1915, and other enactments.

And whereas the said regulations have been amended by various subsequent Orders in Council

And whereas owing to the suspension of hostilities it is expedient that many of the said regulations should be revoked:

Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to

order, and it is hereby ordered, that the following amendments be made in the said regulations:—

1. Regulations 41D and 41DD are hereby revoked.

2. The regulation mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked to the extent specified in the second column of that Schedule.

REGULATION PARTIALLY REVOKED.

No. of Regulation.	Extent of Revocation.
30F	In paragraph (4) the words "or (b) buy or sell any stock, shares, or other securities which have at any time since the 30th September, 1914, been in physical possession outside the United Kingdom.
