The following Amendments of the Statutes of Queen's College, Oxford, made by the Governing Body of the College on the 24th June, 1919, and sealed on the 18th October, 1919, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877":—

Whereas it is expedient to raise the pensions payable to Fellows, and to raise the maximum income from the emoluments of a living or from a public office which constitutes a disability to a pension, to a more reasonable amount:

The College, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, and of any other power enabling it, at a General Meeting of the Governing Body, specially summoned for the purpose, and after due notice, held upon the 21st day of June, 1919, by the unanimous vote of the persons present and voting made the following amendments to a Statute made by the University Commissioners for the Queen's College, Oxford, and ordered them to be submitted to His Majesty in Council, to be dealt with as provided by the said Act:

1. "In Statt. Tit. XIII, Cl. 4 (b), line 5,

for ten pounds, read fifteen pounds, and in the last line of the clause, for two hundred pounds, read three hundred pounds."

2. "In Statt. Tit. XIII, Cl. 7, line 12, for three hundred pounds, read five hundred pounds."
