PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS in pursuance of the Bishopricks Act, 1878, and the Bishopricks of Bradford and Coventry Act, 1918; the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, by an Instrument under their Common Seal, dated the 31st July, 1919, have certified to His

Majesty that the annual value of the Endowment Fund of the Bishopric of Bradford, together with the annual sum which will ultimately be derived, in pursuance of the above mentioned Acts, from the endowment or income of the Bishopric of Ripon (when calculated in the manner directed by the said Bishopricks Act, 1878, as modified by the First Schedule to the said Bishopricks of Bradford and Coventry Act, 1918), is not less than two thousand five hundred pounds, and that an Episcopal Residence has not yet been provided for the said Bishopric of Bradford, but that a capital sum (in addition to the sum necessary to produce the annual value so certified as aforesaid) sufficient in their opinion for providing a fitting Episcopal Residence for the said Bishopric has been contributed for that purpose:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the above-mentioned Acts, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order and declare as follows:—

(1) The Bishopric of Bradford is hereby founded.

(2) The Diocese of the said Bishopric shall consist (subject to the provisions contained in the First Schedule to the Bishopricks of Bradford and Coventry Act,
