

to or be vested in the Council and of any lands on which such springs are or may be situate or which it may be convenient to use for the purposes of or in connection with such springs or the utilisation or development thereof or for the provision of pump rooms, baths or other buildings, works and conveniences, or to grant to any company, body or person a lease or leases of any baths, pump rooms or other buildings provided by the Council, and the appliances, machinery, plant and apparatus connected therewith.

To authorize the Council to close to the public and reserve for such periods and for such purposes as they may think fit the exclusive use of any building or bath provided by them under the powers of the Bill or any part of any such building, and to grant the use thereof to any company, body or person for such period or periods, and for such purposes as the Council may approve, and on and subject to such terms and conditions as to payment and otherwise as the Council may think fit.

To authorize the Council to make charges for admission to the said springs and lands on which the same are situate, baths, pump rooms and buildings or any of them or any part or parts thereof, the use of baths provided by the Council, and the use of any appliances, fittings, apparatus or conveniences provided by the Council as aforesaid, and to authorise the Council to make charges for any mineral waters or other water supplied by them.

To authorize the Council to supply in such manner at such places at such times and in such quantities as the Council may think fit water obtained from any springs for the time being belonging to or vested in them or in which they have an interest and to make charges for any water so supplied.

To authorize the Council to make bye-laws and regulations with reference to the management and control of any such lands, springs, buildings, pump rooms and baths as aforesaid, and for securing the good and orderly conduct of persons resorting thereto.

To authorize the Council to advertise any springs for the time being belonging to or vested in them or under their control, and any baths, pump rooms, buildings, and conveniences provided by the Council, and also to advertise the advantages and amenities of the district or any part thereof as a health resort, watering place or spa and otherwise.

To confer further powers on the Council with reference to the provision or employment of a band or bands of music and the payment or contribution towards the payment of such band or bands, and to increase the amount which by section 9 of the Llandrindod Wells Urban District Council Act, 1905, the Council are authorized to pay or contribute towards the payment of a public band of music for the district.

To confer powers upon the Council with reference to the provision, maintenance and regulation of markets within the district, and to provide that the Council shall have jurisdiction over markets within the district.

To provide that stalls and standings for the sale of market produce and any other goods and commodities shall be held only in the new market place at Llandrindod Wells or at such other place or places within the district as the Council may from time to time appoint.

To empower the Council to construct, establish, maintain, extend, and enlarge a market or markets, market place or market places, with

all necessary buildings erections, stalls, shops, pens and conveniences for the display of goods animals and things, or of such other goods animals and things as may be prescribed in or provided for by the Bill.

To prohibit the holding of any market, fair or the sale of goods, animals or things from any booths, stalls or pens, or in or upon any public road, street or place within the district otherwise than with the license or permission of the Council.

To authorize the Council to make charges including rents, stallages and tolls in respect of the use of any market or market place, and in respect of stalls, booths, shops, standings and other erections or buildings and conveniences provided at or in connection with any market or market place and in respect of goods, animals, articles or things exposed or displayed for sale, in or at any market or market place, and to provide for the recovery of any such rents, stallages, tolls and other charges.

To prohibit obstructions in streets or roads within the district, or interference with the traffic along the same by the standing of carts or other vehicles and caravans, or from booths, stalls, shows or otherwise, and to authorize the Council to remove any such obstruction and to prevent any such interference.

To make provision as to unclaimed goods, animals, articles or things left in any market or market place, and to authorize the Council to dispose of the same by sale or otherwise and as to the application of the proceeds of any such sale.

To authorize the Council to let or grant a lease of any such market or market place, or of any part thereof, or any building, erection, stall, booth, shop, pen, standing or convenience therein or thereon or connected therewith, or of the rents, stallages, tolls or other charges receivable by the Council in respect thereof upon such terms and conditions as the Council may think fit or as may be prescribed or provided for by the Bill.

To confer upon the Council further powers with regard to the provision and regulation of slaughterhouses within the district and conveniences connected therewith to authorize the Council to acquire by agreement premises within the district for the purposes of slaughtering cattle or any interest in such premises; to agree with owners, lessees and occupiers of slaughterhouses for the abolition of slaughtering therein; to prohibit (when the Council shall have provided a slaughterhouse) the slaughtering of animals within the district and beyond the district within one mile from the boundary thereof except in a slaughterhouse provided by the Council; to make provision as to the payment of compensation to owners, lessees and occupiers of slaughterhouses in certain cases and the determination thereof; and to authorize the Council to demand and recover fees, rent or other charges in respect of the use of any slaughterhouse or any conveniences connected therewith provided by the Council.

To make further provision with reference to licences for slaughterhouses and the grant thereof by the Council and to authorise the Council to refuse to grant or renew such licences in such circumstances as may be defined in or prescribed by the Bill.

To authorize the Council by bye-law otherwise to restrict the use of any premises licensed as a slaughterhouse, to the use of such premises and to define or to limit
