PROFITEERING ACT, 1919.

Whereas by the Profiteering Act, 1919 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), certain powers are conferred on the Board of Trade with a view to the checking of profiteering:

And whereas under Section 2 of the Act the Board of Trade are empowered to authorize Local Authorities to establish Local Committees and to delegate to those committees any or all of the powers of the Board under the Act in respect of any articles or classes of articles or sales (except the power of the Board to fix prices), and to make regulations and give directions as to the constitution, powers and procedure of committees so established:

And whereas certain Local Authorities in Ireland may deem it expedient to join in estab-

lishing a Joint Local Committee:

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade, in the exercise of the above recited powers, do hereby make the regulations and give the directions set out in the Schedule hereto as to the constitution, powers and procedure of such Joint Local Committees as may be established by Local Authorities in Ireland with the consent of the Board of Trade.
