THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT, 1868.

THE GOVERNING BODY OF HARROW SCHOOL having, on the 11th day of November, 1919, in virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the above-named Act, made a Statute in the terms appended hereto amending Statute IV. of the existing Statutes of the said School, the said Statute is hereby published in the London Gazette in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in the said Act.

And Notice is hereby given, that any person, body of persons, or body corporate, authorized in that behalf by the said Act, may, within two months after the publication of this notification, petition His Majesty in Council to withhold His approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

STATUTE made by the Governing Body of Harrow School on the 11th day of November, 1919.

“ WHEREAS Statutes for the Government of Harrow School were made by the Governing Body of the said School under the Public Schools Act, 1868, and approved and sealed by the Special Commissioners appointed for the purposes of the said Act on the 24th day of February, 1874:

“ And whereas the said Governing Body, in exercise of the powers for this purpose con-

ferred upon them by Section Eleven of the said Act, have resolved to alter Statute IV. of the said Statutes in manner hereinafter appearing:—

“ Be it enacted as follows:—

1. From and after the date of His Majesty's Order in Council approving this Statute, the Lower School of John Lyon and the funds appropriated thereto shall be managed and administered according to the direction and under the superintendence of a Committee of Management appointed wholly or partly by the Governing Body of Harrow School, and such Committee shall be the Governing Body of the said Lower School of John Lyon:

2. The fees payable by each boy at the said Lower School of John Lyon may exceed Twelve pounds per annum, but shall not exceed Fifteen pounds per annum:

3. In all other respects Statute IV. of the above-mentioned Statutes shall remain in force:
