THE RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT  
(COUNTY COURTS ACT), 1920.

ORDER LIV.

1. Rule 12A of Order LIV. shall be amended by adding at the end thereof the words " or the County Courts Act, 1919."

2. An application under section 17 of the County Courts Act, 1919, for the issue of a commission, request or order to examine witnesses abroad for the purposes of an action or matter in a County Court may be made to a Master at Chambers in the King's Bench Division by Summons. Such Summons shall be intitled " In the High Court of Justice, King's Bench Division " and " In the Matter of an action (or matter) depending in the
