## THE RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT

 (COUNTY COURTS ACT), 1920.
## Order LIV.

1. Rule 12^ of Order LIV. shall be amended by adding at the end thereof the words "or the County Courts Act, 1919.'
2. An application under section 17 of the County Courts Act, 1919, for the issue of a commission, request or order to examine witnesses abroad for the purposes of an action or matter in a County Court may be made to a Master at Chambers in the King's Bench Division by Summons. Such Summons shall be intituled "In the High Court of Justice, King's Bench Division" and "In the Matter of an action (or matter) depending in the
