NOTICE TO AIRMEN (No. 26).

AERIAL LIGHTHOUSE AT BIGGIN HILL.

*It is hereby notified that:—*

Further to assist Airmen flying on the London-Paris route, an experimental Lighthouse has been erected at Biggin Hill Aerodrome. This Lighthouse is in operation every evening from half an hour before sunset to two hours after sunset. It gives two flashes every eight seconds, thus:—Flash one second; eclipse one second; flash one second; eclipse five seconds. Biggin Hill Aerodrome is in a position 108° 7 miles from Croydon Aerodrome and 117° 20 miles from Hounslow Aerodrome.
