

**BRITISH NATIONALITY AND STATUS
OF ALIENS ACTS, 1914 AND 1918.**

In the Matter of Nicholas Luxenburg.

Revocation of Certificate of Naturalisation.

Whereas I am satisfied as the result of an enquiry conducted by the Certificates of Naturalisation (Revocation) Committee that Nicholas Luxenburg, to whom a certificate of naturalisation numbered A6994 was granted on the 3rd February, 1892 (1) obtained his Certificate by false representation; (2) has shown himself by act and speech to be disaffected and disloyal to His Majesty; and (3) has during the war unlawfully traded and communicated with subjects of an enemy State.

Now, therefore, by this Order made in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914, I revoke the said certificate and I direct such revocation to have effect from the date hereof, and I further order the said certificate to be given up and to be cancelled.

In the Matter of Erny Hermann Ford.

Revocation of Certificate of Naturalisation.

Whereas I am satisfied as the result of an enquiry conducted by the Certificates of Naturalisation (Revocation) Committee that the certificate of naturalisation numbered 13322 granted to Erny Hermann Ford on the 24th March, 1903, was obtained by false representation.

Now, therefore, by this Order made in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914, I revoke the said certificate and I direct such revocation to have effect from the date hereof, and I further order the said certificate to be given up and to be cancelled.

And I further direct that Erny Hermann Ford shall cease to be a British subject.
