SUMMARY.

The foregoing list contains 310 cases, viz. :—6 American, 4 Austrian, 7 Czecho-Slovak, 4 Danish, 4 Dutch, 5 French, 23 German, 17 Italian, 27 Polish, 186 Russian, 9 Swedish, 4 Swiss and 14 of other Nationalities.

26 of the cases (including 1 American, 1 Belgian, 19 German, 1 Hungarian, 1 Russian, 1 Swedish and 1 Swiss) are British-born widows.

248 of the cases (including 4 American, 3 Austrian, 7 Czecho-Slovak, 1 Danish, 1 Dutch, 5 French, 3 German, 14 Italian, 1 Norwegian, 26 Polish, and 169 Russian) are men who have served in the British or Allied Forces during the War.
