The following Areas are now " Movement Areas " for the purposes of Part I. of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920:—

Inverness—(1) An Area comprising the islands known as the Outer Hebrides (*except the islands of St. Kilda, Dune, Soay, and Boreray*), in the county of Inverness.

(2) An Area in the county of Inverness, comprising the islands known as Skye or Inner Hebrides.

Merioneth.—An Area comprising:—

In the administrative county of Merioneth.

Such portions of the parishes of Llangar and Llandrillo as lie to the east of the road running from Corwen via Cynwyd, Llandrillo and Blaen-y-cwm to its junction with the road running from Bala to Llangynog;

In the administrative county of Montgomery.

Such portions of the parishes of Llangynog, Llanrhaiadr-ym-Mochnant, and Pennant as lie to the north, north-east and north-west of the road running from Bala via Llangynog, Penybont Fawr, to the village of Llanrhaiadr-ym-Mochnant; and

In the administrative county of Denbigh.

Such portions of the parishes of Llanrhaiadr-ym-Mochnant, Llanarmon Mynydd Mawr, Llansilin, and Llanarmon Dyffryn Ceiriog as

lie to the north-west of the road running from Penybont Fawr through the village of Llanrhaiadr-ym-Mochnant via Llidart and Cae Hir to the village of Llanarmon Dyffryn Ceiriog, but excluding that portion of the parish of Llanarmon Dyffryn Ceiriog which lies to the north and north-east of the River Ceiriog.

See also under Denbigh and Montgomery.

Montgomery.—An Area in the administrative county of Montgomery, comprising such portion of the parish of Llanbrynmair as lies to the north of the road from Newtown to Machynlleth (but excluding that road), and such portion of the parish of Cemmaes as lies to the east of the road from Cemmaes Road to Mallwynd and to the south of a line drawn from a point on the said road 110 yards or thereabouts south of Dolcorllwyn Hall Lodge, thence in an easterly direction to Blaen-cwm-Llinau Farm, and continuing in an easterly direction to Nant hir Farm to a point on the eastern boundary of Cemmaes Parish 726 yards or thereabouts north of Blaen-y-cwm, in the administrative county of Montgomery.—*See also under Merioneth.*

Ross and Cromarty.—An Area comprising the Island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
