The following Statute, made by the Governing Body of Sidney Sussex College, Cambridge, on the 13th day of December, 1920, and sealed on the same day, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877:—

STATUTE to alter and amend the Statutes of Sidney Sussex College, in the University of Cambridge, which amending Statute was duly made at a Meeting of the Governing Body of the College, specially summoned for this purpose, and held on the thirteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and having been passed at such meeting by the votes of more than two-thirds of the persons present and voting, is now submitted for the approval of His Majesty the King in Council.

We, the Master, Fellows and Scholars of the said College, in exercise of the powers given to us by the 54th Section of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, do hereby

alter and amend the Statutes of our said College by adding the following paragraph to Chapter XVIII of the said Statutes, intituled "Of stipends, allowances and Rooms," to form paragraph 4 of the same Statute:—

4. There shall also be paid to the Master and to each Fellow such an allowance in respect of Income Tax on the dividends payable to them respectively under the next succeeding Statute as the Governing Body shall determine.
