Description and Limits of Infected Place.

The premises known as "Larport Farm," in the occupation of Harry Griffiths Pitt, in the parish of Mordiford, in the administrative county of Hereford.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 20TH DECEMBER 1920.)

KENT (WINGHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 5).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. The Kent (Wingham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920, and the Kent (Wingham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (Nos. 2, 3 and 4), hereinafter referred to as "the existing Orders," are modified in the manner hereinafter appearing.

2. The Scheduled District for the purposes of the existing Orders shall be the district described in the First Schedule hereto.

3.—(1) The Area described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order."

(2) Part III of the principal Order shall apply to such parts of the Scheduled District, which includes the said Prohibited Area, as are not within the Prohibited Area.

(3) The provisions of Article 2 of the Kent (Wingham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 shall continue to apply to the

Prohibited Area, and the provisions of Article 6 of the "principal Order" shall be read and have effect subject to this modification.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty.

5. This Order may be cited as the KENT (WINGHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 5), and shall be read with the existing Orders.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Scheduled District.

A district in the administrative county of Kent, comprising the boroughs of Deal and Sandwich (*excluding the parish of Sarre*), and the parishes, including any detached parts thereof, of Stonar, Ash, Woodnesborough, Staple, Goodnestone, Chillenden, Nonington, Barfreton, Eythorne, Waldershare, West Langdon, Little Mongeham, Sutton, Ripple, Oxney, Ringwould, Walmer, Great Mongeham, Northbourne, Tilmanstone, Knowlton, Eastry, Betteshanger, Ham, Sholden, and Worth, and the detached part of the parish of Wingham.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Prohibited Area.

An area, in the administrative county of Kent, comprising the parishes of Betteshanger, Ham, including its detached part, Northbourne (*except its detached parts, save as hereinafter specified*), and Tilmanstone, such portions of the parish of Eastry as lie to the south and east of a line commencing at the junction of the parish boundaries of Nonington, Eastry and Tilmanstone, thence in a north-easterly direction along the road leading to Eastry via the Infectious Diseases Hospital and the Eastry Workhouse, thence crossing Roman Road at Eastry and proceeding along Brook Lane and its continuation past Little Hay to a point where this road meets the parish boundary between Eastry and Ham, and such portions of the parish of Little Mongeham and the adjoining detached part of the parish of Northbourne as lie to the north of the road from Little Mongeham via East Studdal, Studdal and Ashley to Malmains Farm.
