AIR MINISTRY NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

No. 139 of the year 1920.

BELGIUM: CUSTOMS EXAMINATION;
AERODROMES.

(355041/20—368608/20.)

It is hereby notified:

1. The attention of pilots is drawn to the
fact that Article 19 of the Belgian Air Naviga-
tion Regulations (Belgian Royal Decree
6303/1919) contains the following clause:—

*Any aircraft coming from abroad or going
abroad must land at or depart from a Customs
aerodrome.*

The *only* Customs aerodrome in Belgium at
present is Haren (formerly Haren-Evere), at
which *all* aeroplanes arriving in or departing
from Belgium must undergo Customs examina-
tion and clearance.

2. The following information regarding
Haren aerodrome has been received from the
Belgian Government:—

HAREN. Military and Civil Aerodrome.

Position.—Latitude 50° 53' 0" N., Longitude
4° 25' 0" E. Situated 6 km. N.E. of the
centre of Brussels, just east of Evere.

Maximum dimensions for landing.—950 ×
780 metres.

Wind Indicators and Day Markings.—One
wind sleeve above the wooden hangar and one
above the military airship shed. A white circle
is marked on the aerodrome.

Night Landing Arrangements.—An aerial
lighthouse giving intermittent flashes, forming
the letter "S" of the Morse code is in opera-
tion from sunset to one hour after sunset, or
whenever a machine is expected, and also
