MARCH FIFTH DRAINAGE DISTRICT.

INCREASE OF RATING AND BORROWING POWERS.

Notice is hereby given, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has settled and made an Order conferring on the Commissioners for the above named District additional powers of levying taxes and of borrowing for the more effectual drainage of their District, and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice a memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Ministry by some person or body affected by the Order and having such interest as is prescribed by Article 4 of the Land Drainage Regulations, 1918 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1918, No. 1605), as being sufficient for the purpose.

A copy of the sealed Order has been deposited for public inspection at the office of Henry Coy, Esq., Clerk to the March Fifth Drainage District Commissioners, Grays Lane, March, for the period of thirty days from the date hereof. ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF

KENT (WINGHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-
AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF
1920 (No. 6).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Further Contraction of Scheduled District.

1. The Kent (Wingham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 shall apply only to the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and that Area, subject to the modification contained in Article 2 of the first mentioned Order, shall continue to be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty.

3. This Order may be cited as the KENT (WINGHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 6), and shall be read with the Kent (Wingham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920.

SCHEDULE.

Prohibited Area.

An Area, in the administrative county of Kent, comprising the parishes of Betteshanger, Ham, including its detached part, Northbourne (*except its detached parts, save as hereinafter specified*), and Tilmanstone, such portions of the parish of Eastry as lie to the south and east of a line commencing at the junction of the parish boundaries of Nomington, Eastry and Tilmanstone, thence in a north-easterly direction along the road leading to Eastry via the Infectious Diseases Hospital and the Eastry Workhouse, thence crossing Roman Road at Eastry and proceeding along Brook Lane and its continuation past Little Hay to a point where this road meets the parish boundary between Eastry and Ham, and such portions of the parish of Little Mongeham and the adjoining detached part of the parish of Northbourne as lie to the north of the road from Little Mongeham via East Studdal, Studdal and Ashley to Malmains Farm.
