FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE:
INFECTED PLACE.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

The premises mentioned in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be a place infected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease.

MIDLAND COUNTIES (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1921
(No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Reduction of Area under restrictions in
Midland Counties.*

1. (1) The Midland Counties (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Orders of 1920 and 1921 and the Midland Counties (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1921 (No. 2) are hereby revoked.

(2) Parts I. and IV. of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order," shall, subject as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order; apply to the two Scheduled Districts described in the First Schedule hereto, which shall be Scheduled Districts for the purposes of the Principal Order.

(3) Part III. of the Principal Order shall apply to such parts of the said Scheduled Districts as are not in a Prohibited Area declared by this Order.

Declaration of Three Prohibited Areas.

2. The Areas described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be Prohibited Areas for the purposes of the Principal Order.

Movement within the Prohibited Areas.

3.—(i.) Where an Inspector of the Ministry considers it necessary or expedient, after inquiry, that an animal in a prohibited Area should be permitted to be moved within such Area or often as occasion may require between different parts of the same farm, he may, notwithstanding any prohibition of movement con-
