

COAL TRANSPORT ORDER, 1917.

REVOCATION OF DIRECTIONS.

1. The Directions of the Controller of Coal Mines, dated the 17th day of September, 1920, given under the above named Order in relation to the transport of coal by sea from Mersey, Lancashire, and Cumberland ports are hereby revoked.

2. Nothing herein contained shall affect or prejudice any matter or thing done or suffered, proceeding taken, or penalty incurred under the said Directions during or in respect of the time prior to their revocation.
