Notice is hereby given, under Section 69 of the Sea Fisheries Act, 1868, that it is proposed to submit to His Majesty in Council the draft of an Order in Council for the revocation of the Order in Council of the 29th April, 1869 (made in pursuance of the said Act), directing the observance of a Bye-law made by the Irish Fishery Commissioners fixing the close time for the taking of Oysters in certain specified waters.
