At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of April, 1921.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 5th day of April, 1921 (C.W. 3798/21), in the words following, viz. :—

“Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions, and other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman, or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner, and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council:

“And whereas Your Majesty was graciously pleased by Your Order in Council bearing date the 22nd day of January, 1920, to authorize the payment of allowances on the following scale to the Senior Lieutenant of vessels in Full or Reserve Commission :

A. *Ships in Full Commission.*

When Senior of a ship allowed by authorized

complement a Captain in Command, but not allowed a Commander—

To Warrant Officers, Commissioned Warrant Officers, Mates, Sub-Lieutenants, Lieutenants and Lieutenant Commanders 2s. 6d.

When Senior of a ship allowed by authorized complement a Commander, Lieutenant Commander or Lieutenant in Command—

To Warrant Officers, Commissioned Warrant Officers, Mates, Sub-Lieutenants, Lieutenants and Lieutenant Commanders 1s. 6d.

B. *Ships in Reserve.*

To Warrant Officers, Commissioned Warrant Officers, Mates, Sub-Lieutenants, Lieutenants and Lieutenant Commanders—

For grouped ships of and above Light Cruiser status, whether commanded by a Captain or by a Commander. } Parent Ship } 2s. 6d.
Tenders } 1s. 6d.

For ships of and above Light Cruiser status when not grouped and for Destroyer Depot Ships, Flotilla Leaders and Minelayers 1s. 6d.
