

Order shall be in force for four days, inclusive of the day of issue.

(3) A copy of a licence under this Order shall be sent by the Inspector granting the licence to the Clerk of the Local Authority of the District in which the place of detention is situate.

Movement from Landing Place subject to other Orders and to Regulations.

8.—Nothing in this Order or in any Order relating to the landing or movement of animals brought from Ireland shall be deemed to authorise the movement of an animal in contravention of any other Order of the Minister or of a Regulation of a Local Authority.

PART IV.—GENERAL.

Offences.

9.—(1) If any animal shall be landed or removed in contravention of this Order or is not isolated or slaughtered as required by this Order or by the conditions of a licence granted thereunder, the owner thereof, and the owner and the lessee and the occupier of the Landing Place, and the person causing, directing, or permitting the landing or movement, and the owner and person in charge of the animal which is not so isolated or slaughtered, and the owner and the charterer, and the master of the vessel from which the same is landed, as the case may be, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts or defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

(2) If any person, with a view unlawfully to evade or defeat the operation of this Order, before the expiration of the period of detention, takes out, effaces, or obliterates, or attempts to take out, efface, or obliterate, any mark on any animal affixed under this Order, the person doing the same, and the person causing, directing or permitting the same to be done, and the owner of the animal, and the person for the time being in charge thereof, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts and defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Commencement.

10. This Order shall come into operation at mid-day on the fifth day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.

Short Title.

11. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 10).

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 5TH MAY, 1921.)

MANCHESTER (LANDING OF ANIMALS) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Revocation.

1. The Manchester (Landing of Animals) Order of 1921 is hereby revoked.

Definition of Irish Animals Landing Place.

2. All that space at Mode Wheel, Trafford Park, situate between the Manchester Ship Canal and Trafford Wharf Road, in the administrative county of Lancaster, which is coloured pink on the plan sealed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries for the purposes of this Order, and deposited at the Ministry, is hereby defined as a Landing Place for Irish animals.

Definition of Foreign Animals Wharf.

3. All that space at Mode Wheel, Trafford Park, situate between the Manchester Ship Canal and Trafford Wharf Road, in the administrative county of Lancaster, which is coloured blue on the plan referred to in Article 2 of this Order, is hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

4. This Order may be cited as the MANCHESTER (LANDING OF ANIMALS) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).
