WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant out of our common fund to the Incumbent for the time being of each of the benefices with cure of souls whereof the names and the names of the counties whereof the same are respectively situate are stated in the first two columns of the Schedule hereto annexed the perpetual annual sums set opposite the names of the benefices respectively in the fourth and fifth columns of the said Schedule, such annual sums to be payable yearly on the thirty-first day of December in each and every year, for the purpose of perpetually discharging the first-fruits and tenths payable in respect of the said benefices to the Governors of Queen Anne's Bounty, the

yearly payments to be made by us, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, to the said Governors of Queen Anne's Bounty for that purpose, and to be taken for all purposes as payments made to the Incumbents of the said benefices, and to be accepted by the said Governors of Queen Anne's Bounty as discharging the said Incumbents from all liability in respect of first-fruits and tenths: Provided always, that the first of such yearly payments shall be made by us on the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette, and shall be in respect of the year ended the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty.
